



# One-day Tour to the Hong Kong Palace Museum

**【Trip Overview】** The Hong Kong Palace Museum at the West Kowloon Cultural District showcases over 900 precious artifacts from the Palace Museum through innovative curatorial approaches. The vast majority of these treasured collections are being presented in Hong Kong for the first time. Spanning approximately 13,000 square feet, the museum's interior design and overall style preserve the architectural features of the Forbidden City. Through exhibitions of various precious collections and artifacts, visitors can gain fresh perspectives on Qing dynasty court life and explore traditional Chinese craftsmanship and architectural characteristics. The museum regularly presents special exhibitions, making it an unmissable destination for art and culture enthusiasts. It also features the Palace Academy, multimedia facilities, interactive installations, and dining and leisure spaces, offering everyone a unique cultural experience.

## Sai Gon Volcanic Rock Day Tour

When the tide recedes, the natural tombolo emerges, revealing a pathway of rocks of all sizes that connects the two islands. The crystal-clear waters are perfect for sunset viewing and photography, making it an ideal spot for a leisurely stroll and photo-taking!

It has served as a filming location for many Hong Kong films and television productions.</p> <p>Central Market stands as a testament to the city's transformation—from a traditional market in the past to a revitalized commercial complex</p>



	<p>today, carrying the collective memory of Hong Kong's history. It also offers a vibrant cultural experience space for visitors to explore.</p>

<p>13 : 00- 16 : 00</p>	<p><b>In-Depth Stroll Through Old Streets of Central</b>  <b>Begin your journey at the heart of Central by riding the Central-Mid-Levels Escalator, recognized by the Guinness World Records as the longest outdoor covered escalator system in the world. Visit the historic Old Central Police Station, which vividly reflects the architectural and cultural colors of the colonial era.</b>  <b>Continue to Man Mo Temple, the oldest temple on Hong Kong Island. The temple houses numerous ancient relics, offering insights into the literary culture and customs of the time.</b>  <b>The surrounding area, known as Possession Street (Water Hang Hau), marks the spot where British forces first landed in Hong Kong after the outbreak of the Opium War.</b>  <b>Explore Cat Street (Upper Lascar Row) , one of Hong Kong's famous tourist destinations and once a Settlement for Indian sailors during the early days of the colony.</b>  <b>Admire Western Market, a declared monument and the oldest market building in Hong Kong. Its structure exemplifies the Edwardian architectural style.</b>  <b>Finally, hop on a century-old tram (ding ding) for a leisurely ride along Hong Kong Island to the Legislative Council Building. This iconic route is a familiar filming location for TVB dramas and has become a must-visit experience for travelers to Hong Kong.</b></p>
